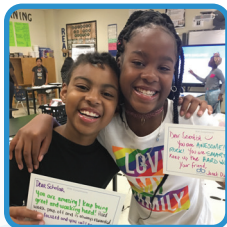

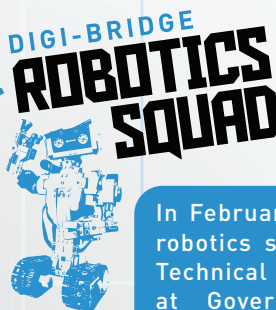
#STEAM SATURDAYS

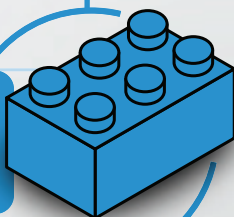
