Position Summary

Digi-Bridge is currently hiring **two experienced educators** to facilitate a speciality program centered on Environmental Sustainability. The program involves a cohort of 20 middle school students meeting weekly on Thursdays from 5-7pm at the Digi-Bridge office. Additionally, there are once a month field trips on Saturdays from 9am-1pm. The students study, explore, and engage in five modules centered on different aspects of environmental sustainability. Modules and curriculum topics are set by the Digi-Bridge team. Facilitators will instruct small groups of students on the various topics and supervise the cohort. Curriculum and materials will be provided as well as extensive training.

These are contract positions and **facilitators will be paid hourly for training, prepwork, and facilitation.** All training on our educational philosophy as well as curriculum and materials will be provided. Sessions will take place at Digi-Bridge's office at 820 Hamilton Street, Charlotte, NC 28206.

- Engaging scholars in meaningful conversations before, during and after each lesson
- Maintaining supplies used for each lesson
- Embracing the constructivist mindset by guiding scholars when they hit roadblocks without giving them the answers
- Collecting program data in support of evaluation efforts
- Engaging with community shareholders and promoting course opportunities by identifying specific community education needs
- Miscellaneous duties as assigned by Digi-Bridge staff to meet program needs
